Statement of Program Service Accomplishments

During 2008 NDI extended relief efforts to Bacalar, Mexico where Dr. Jacqui McGrath began operations and hosted her first interns and preceptors. NDI also had an intern produce 2 short films about NDI, one in Spanish and one in English. We continued to be involved with the government of Nicaragua's Ministry of Health and comply with all contracts and on April 2, 2008, NDI signed a new contract with the Ministry of Health under the new authority of the Sandinista run government which is in effect for 3 years. On the Island of Ometepe, NDI expanded our clinic space at Moyogalpa Hospital and established a permanent presence in 3 additional community clinics. Our involvement in community projects continued in many areas including environmental projects in Nicaragua and Mexico, community youth projects and hospital improvements. Efforts with Health Bridges International to install water purification unit in the town of Los Angeles, Ometepe began and the initial site visit was done by the HBI team, a location was selected, and the initial building was completed. We also added a second full time doctor in Nicaragua, bringing the naturopathic physician total to 3 in Nicaragua. On an international front, NDI continued collaborating with international organizations and universities like Grand Valley State. Our NDI Research Branch developed and the initiation of a research study into the role of Guava on diarrheal diseases began, completing phase one development of the research project which will take place in 2009/2010. The NDI Global Health Policy Branch also developed, and NDI began developing initial assessment of Zambia and ZINARE and a collaboration with ZINARE was initiated. We expanded our Global Health Courses, completed 4 courses and graduated 41 students and doctors. We implemented a successful internship program which graduated 7 global health interns in 2 countries (6 in Nicaragua, 1 in Mexico). We also implemented and developed a women's health program in Nicaragua, called DIOSA, which brings care and pap exams to local women and offers classes that empower and educate on health. We donated more than \$50,000 USD of medicines and medical supplies to international sites and in Nicaragua our doctors reached 7,000 patient visits since our inception. We added a volunteer database and research director position, and this person developed our patient database and established an exemplary dataset from the developing world. We completed a new website without flash for easier access from developing countries and we graduated 1 more global health naturopathic physician from the full year volunteer program,
